## ROAD CONSTRUCTION - RANGE ROAD 135 & RANGE ROAD 95

Saddle Hills County is currently completing reconstruction work on Range Road 135, South of Township Road 765, for two miles and on Range Road 95 (Silver Valley Road), from Township Road 794 to Township Road 800. There is a fair weather detour in place on Range Road 95; signs are posted. A map and detour details is available on our website. We ask that all vehicles please drive with caution through the work zone and be aware of construction equipment in the area.

## ROAD CONSTRUCTION - TOWNSHIP ROAD 810 (DOE RIVER)

Saddle Hills County is completing slide repairs on Township Road 810 by the Doe River. There will be traffic delays while equipment is present. We ask that all vehicles please drive slowly through the construction zone. Thank you for your cooperation.

## ROAD CLOSURE - RANGE ROAD 131

Please note that due to a culvert replacement on Range Road 131, 2 km north of Highway 49, the road in the immediate area will be closed to thru traffic from **September 11-17, 2023**. Traffic should detour via Range Road 134 and Township Road 790 as appropriate during this period. We apologize for any inconvenience.

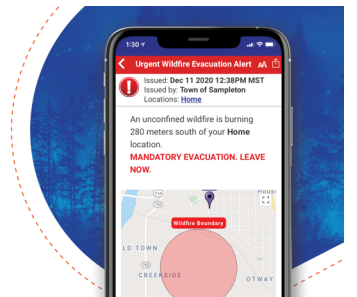
