DRONE NO-FLY ZONES

Drone No-Fly Zones are areas where it may be unsafe or illegal to fly your drone. If you fly a drone in Canada, you must follow the rules that help keep people and aircraft safe. Please ensure you know of all possible restrictions and obtain all necessary permits from governing authorities before flying your drone, and avoid emergency scenes such as traffic accidents and wildfires.

RECYCLE - PLEASE BAG YOUR PESTICIDE CONTAINERS

Bonanza and Blueberry Transfer Stations continue to accept pesticide containers (with contents less than 23l) for recycling. Please note that in order for containers to be accepted they **must** be bagged. Bags are available from retailers at the time of purchase and a small inventory is kept on hand at participating transfer stations. Please bag your containers prior to drop-off, if possible.

2023 TAX PAYMENT DEADLINE

A reminder that the deadline for 2023 property taxes is July 31, 2023. As of August 1, 2023 there will be a 6% penalty applied to the current year's outstanding tax balance. Payments can be made online, through most financial institutions, at the office, or over the phone with a credit card. We accept credit cards, debit cards, and cheques.
