SAFETY TIPS FOR PASSING PLOWS & GRADERS

Please be aware of slow moving graders and snowplows. Our graders and plows use highways to get around the County to ensure all of our roads remain safe and clean.

- Treat graders and plows as slow moving vehicles and only pass when it is safe to.
- Watch for signal lights while on the highway.
- When graders and plows are working please stay further back and only pass when it is safe, or when the operator signals for you to do so.
- Allow graders and plows extra room at intersections as they may be backing up or turning around.
- Stay behind any dust or snow clouds so that oncoming traffic and grader and plow operators can see your vehicle clearly.
