REMOTE POTABLE WATER HAULING SUBSIDY

The Remote Potable Water Hauling Subsidy has been created to provide a fair and equitable subsidy to Saddle Hills County residences that will not be able to connect to the Rural Potable Waterline.

Council has approved two areas for 2025 - Gundy and the area known as Doe River, west of the Pouce Coupe River. Applicants must apply yearly to be included. PRIVATELY OWNED EQUIPMENT LIST


