POSITION DESCRIPTION

1. Operation of assigned equipment (Loader, Excavator, Grader, Truck) or manual tasks assigned by the Public Works Foreman and/or alternate.
2. Responsible for the safe and efficient operation of assigned equipment which may include but is not restricted to; excavator, tandem truck; truck equipped with hydraulic crane, one way plow or hopper sander; truck towing various equipment; steamer; loader; packer; tractor; mower; grader; and survey instruments.
3. Responsible for snow and ice control to the standards and priorities set by the County. Standards will be set by the County on stabilization of gravel road surfaces; ice blading; avoidance of windrows; driveways and private approaches; safety and other operational issues.
4. Responsible to undertake general duties including brushing, erosion control, refuse collection, flagging, gravel checking, surveying, design of roads, ditches and accesses, water drainage, approach construction, culvert installation, loading and hauling gravel; loading, hauling and placing asphalt; general hauling; installation of culverts; snow plowing; sanding; grading; and maintenance of equipment.
5. Responsible to coordinate maintenance operations with other County staff or contractors within the same operational area, to operate in a safe and courteous manner, ensuring that safe working practices are observed at all times, obeying all traffic regulations, respecting the need of the public to access roadways, that complaints are minimized, and no safety hazards result.
6. Responsible for the daily maintenance, servicing, fueling and minor repairs of equipment that have been assigned to them.

Prefer class 1 or 3 license but will consider class 5 for the right candidate.

Performs other related duties as may be requested by the Public Works Supervisor/Foreman.



REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

Ability to operate heavy equipment utilized in road maintenance, providing a high quality of work, high productivity, and minimal wear and tear on equipment; will have an ability to perform maintenance of roads, in both summer and winter conditions.
